- **Methods :**
  - a. Natural – nature is represent in true sense
  - b. Color Scheme – emphasis the beauty of color in materials by combining colors that harmonize, contrast or complement each other. Balance in composition is essential.
  - c. Mass-effect – using volume to produce emphasis. Massing is done by grouping.
  - d. Line-Scheme – opposite of the mass-effect arrangement. Space around the line materials are part of the arrangements. Rhythmic patterns and geometric detail are deployed.
  - e. Abstract – use of material other than plant-life.
