Jacob Chastened: Learning Slow

Genesis 29:1-30 [28:10-15; 31:1-13; 32:9-12, 24-32]

1. Jacob Our Ancestor in the Faith: His Historical Impact

His new God-given name, “Israel,” becomes the name of God’s ancient people! (32:28)

2. Jacob’s Early Life

i. An Unlovable, Unattractive Scoundrel

self-centered, manipulative, narcissistic, back-stabbing, liar!!

ii. Jacob Gets What He Wants But He Doesn’t! (27:27-29)

(Like Macbeth with Duncan and the Scottish throne)

Can you think of parallel situations in our lives?

iii. Jacob Pays For His Behavior All His Life

a. 20 Years of exile (Genesis 28-33)

b. Jacob’s behavior repeated in his sons

Jealous of brother Joseph (37:1-36)

Lying to father Jacob (37:31-35)

3. Jacob’s Later Life: Changed

i. Jacob Remains Imperfect

-- e.g., Favoritism of sons Joseph and Benjamin

ii. Jacob Changes – Is Not the Same!

-- Courageous (32:3-33:17 – returning to brother Esau)

-- Generous (28:20-22; 33:8-11 – though still a little manipulative?)

-- Prayerful and faithful (28:20-22; 31:11-13; 32:9-12, 24-32)

-- Respected by his sons (46-49)

4. Change through Experiencing the Presence of God (28:10-15)

Given the Promises of God (“With you and your descendants”);

See also 31:11-13; 32:1-2, 24-31

Given the Grace of God

(“Not for Jacob’s sake, but for Abraham’s sake”)

Note: The Power of A Second Chance . . .

Old Testament Moses (Exodus 3); Jonah (Jonah 2)

New Testament Peter (John 21); Paul (Galatians 1:11-24)

Dickens – Scrooge

Movies – “Rudy” Rudy Ruedigger;

“Hoosiers” Coach Norman Dale

5. Change Through Experiencing the Absence of God

(29:1-30; 30:25-36)

Cheated by Laban (a taste of his own medicine)

Powerless to respond, yet . . .

Empowered by the Promises of God (28:13-22, 31:13, 32:12)

Genesis 25:13 And **the Lord** stood beside him and said, “I am **the Lord**,
the **GOD** of **Abraham** your father and the **GOD** of **Isaac**;
the land on which you lie I will give to you and to your offspring;
14and your offspring shall be like the dust of the earth, and you shall spread abroad to the
west and to the east and to the north and to the south;
and all the families of the earth shall be blessed in you and in your offspring.
15Know that I am with you
and will keep you wherever you go,
and will bring you back to this land;
for I will not leave you
until I have done what I have promised you.”
