(the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God, the Spirit of Jesus)

Acts 2:38

³⁸Peter said to the crowd: "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and <u>you will</u> receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

MEMORY ACTIVATED BY THE SPIRIT John 14:

The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and *remind you of all that I have said to you*.

FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

Galatians 5:22-23

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control

GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

1 Corinthians 12:7-11

PURPOSE: ⁷To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit

for the common good

⁸For to one is given through the Spirit

- 1. the word of wisdom,
- 2. and to another the word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit;
- 3. to another faith, by the same Spirit;
- 4. and to another gifts of healings, by the same Spirit;
- 5. ¹⁰and to another workings of miracles;
- 6. and to another prophecy;
- 7. and to another discerning of spirits;
- 8. to another different kinds of languages;
- 9. and to another the interpretation of languages.

¹¹But the one and the same Spirit produces all of these, distributing to each one separately as he desires"

1 Corinthians 12:28

- 1. ²⁸And God has appointed in the church first apostles,
- 2. second prophets,
- 3. third teachers;
- 4. then deeds of power,
- 5. then gifts of healing,
- 6. forms of assistance ("helps")
- 7. forms of leadership,
- 8. various kinds of tongues.

Ephesians 4:11-12

¹¹The gifts he gave were that

- 1. some would be apostles,
- 2. some prophets,
- 3. some evangelists,
- 4. some pastors and teachers,

<u>PURPOSE</u>: ¹²to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

Romans 12:6-8

⁶We have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us:

- 1. prophecy, in proportion to faith;
- 2. ⁷service, in serving ("deaconing");
- 3. the teacher, in teaching;
- 4. 8the exhorter, in exhortation;
- 5. the giver, in generosity;
- 6. the leader, in diligence;
- 7. the compassionate, in cheerfulness.

Exodus 31:2-6 – *Making the House of Worship* (the Tabernacle)

Then the LORD said to Moses, ² "See, I have chosen Bezalel . . . of the tribe of Judah, ³ and <u>I have filled him with the Spirit of God</u>,

- 3. with wisdom 2. with understanding, 3. with knowledge
- 4. and with all kinds of skills

⁴to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, ⁵to cut and set stones,

to work in wood,

and to engage in all kinds of crafts.

⁶ Moreover, I have appointed Oholiab . . of the tribe of Dan, to help him. Also I have given ability to all the skilled workers to make everything I have commanded you: ⁷ the tent of meeting, the ark of the covenant law with the atonement cover on it, and all the other furnishings of the tent.
