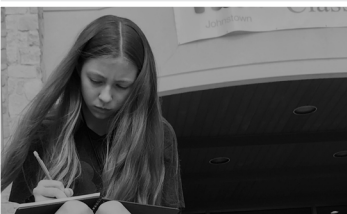

Central Union Mission provides groceries to 4,000 or more individuals and families each month.
