6 We have been discharged from the law of Moses, dead to that which held us captive, so that we are slaves not under the old written code but in the new life of the Spirit. Not that the law is all bad. Indeed, <sup>7</sup> Without God's law, I would not have known what sin was. For example, I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, 'You shall not covet.' <sup>8</sup>But sin, seizing an opportunity in the commandment, produced in me all kinds of covetousness. Apart from God's law sin lies dead...

<sup>12</sup> So, we know that the law of God is holy and just and good. <sup>14</sup> But I am of the flesh, sold into slavery under sin. <sup>15</sup>That is, I do not understand my own actions.

For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate.

<sup>16</sup>Now if I do what I do not want, I agree that the law is good.

<sup>17</sup>Indeed, it is not merely I that break God's law, but sin that dwells within me.

<sup>18</sup>For I know that nothing good dwells within me, that is, in my flesh:

-- I can will what is right, but I cannot do it.

<sup>19</sup>For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I do.

<sup>20</sup>Now, if I do what I do not want, it is no longer merely I that do it, but sin that dwells within me.
