I. God is a Savior

- <u>Psalm 27:1</u> The LORD is my light and <u>my salvation</u>; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- <u>Psalm 18:2</u> The LORD is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer, my God, my rock in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of <u>my salvation</u>, my stronghold.
- <u>Psalm 118:14</u> The LORD is my strength and my might; he has become <u>my</u> <u>salvation.</u>
- <u>Psalm 80:7</u> Restore us, O God of hosts; let your face shine, that we may be saved.
- <u>Isaiah 59:1; 63:1</u> 59:1 See, the Lord's hand is **not too short to save**, nor his ear too dull to hear. 63:1 "Who is this so splendidly robed, marching in his great might?" "It is I, announcing vindication, **mighty to save**."
- Ezekiel 34:22 I will save my flock, and they shall no longer be ravaged; and I will judge between sheep and sheep.
- John 12:47 Do not judge anyone who hears my words and does not keep them, for I came not to judge the world, but to **save** the world.
- Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost.
- **<u>1 Timothy 1:15</u>** The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that **Christ Jesus** came into the world to save sinners.

II We are unable to save ourselves only God can truly save

Ezekiel 7:19 Their silver and gold cannot save them on the day of wrath.

Psalm 33:16 A king is not saved by his great army

<u>Psalm 44:6</u> Not in my bow do I trust, nor can my sword save me.

<u>Acts 15:11</u> We believe that we will be **saved** through the grace of the Lord Jesus.

Ephesians 2:5,8 Even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been **saved**— For by grace you have been **saved** through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God—

III. Saved from What? ... The Power and Consequences of Our Sin

- <u>Matthew 1:21</u> ...will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.
- <u>2 Timothy 4:18</u> The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

Jeremiah 51:45 Save your lives, each of you, from the fierce anger of the Lord!

<u>Romans 5:9-10</u> Much more surely then, now that we have been justified by his

blood, will we be saved through him from the wrath of God.

IV. Hell and Heaven don't seem to be God's only interest

Jeremiah 29:7 Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.

<u>Matthew 6:10</u> Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

V The Bible mentions many things to be saved from

Psalm 118:25 - from failure

Save us, we beseech you, O Lord! (= "Hosanna"!) O Lord, give us success **<u>1 Samuel 4:3</u>** – *from enemies*

Let us bring the ark of the covenant of the Lord here from Shiloh, so that the Lord may come among us and **save us from the power of our enemies**." (Philistines! Assyrians! Babylonians!)

2 Samuel 22:3 -- from violence, danger

My God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of *my salvation*, my stronghold and my refuge, my savior; **you save me from violence**.

Matthew 14:30 -- from drowning!

But when Simon Peter noticed the strong wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "**Lord, save me**!"

Psalm 106: 47 -- from exile

Save us, O Lord our God, and gather us from among the nations

Isaiah 56:1 -- from injustice

Thus says the Lord: **Maintain justice**, and do what is right, for soon *my salvation* will come, and my deliverance be revealed.

Exodus 14:30; 15:2 -- from slavery, destruction, weakness

Thus the Lord saved Israel that day from the Egyptians;

Isaiah 17:10-11 -- hunger

For you have forgotten the God of your **salvation**, and have not remembered the Rock of your refuge; therefore, though you plant pleasant plants . . . yet the harvest will flee away in a day of grief and incurable pain.

Psalm 107:13 -- from distress

Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress Ezek 37:23 -- from disobedience (sin)

I will save them from all the apostasies into which they have fallen, and will cleanse them. Then they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Psalm 85:4 -- for Renewal

Restore us again, O God of our salvation

Matthew 16:25 -- from Meaninglessness and eternity

For **those who want to <u>save</u> their life will lose it**, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it.

Luke 7:50 -- from sin and alienation

And he said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace." (woman who anoints Jesus)

VI. How Do we find and experience "Salvation"?

Acts 16:30-34 "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

They answered, "Believe on the Lord Jesus, and *you will be saved*, you and your household."

<u>A. Entering a deliberate relationship</u> with God and God's Son, Jesus Christ

Romans 10:13 (Joel 2:32)

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

<u>Luke 19:9-10</u>

Then Jesus said to Zacchaeus, "**Today salvation has come to this house**, because he too is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek out and **to save** the lost."

Revelation 3:20

Behold! I stand at the door and knock; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you, and you with me.

<u>John 17</u>

<u>And this is eternal life</u>, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.

B. Maintaining a deliberate relationship with God and God's Son, Jesus Christ

Philippians 2:12

Therefore, my beloved...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;

1 Corinthians 15:2-4

Now I would remind you, brothers and sisters, of the good news that I proclaimed to you, which you in turn received, in which also you stand, **through which also you are being saved**, <u>if you hold firmly to the message that I proclaimed to you</u>— unless you have come to believe in vain. Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures. He was buried and raised again on the third day...

Matthew 24:13

the one who endures to the end will be saved.



Revelation 3:20 (Holman Hunt, 1851-53)
