For reflection:

- "A whole generation grew up who neither knew the Lord nor what he had done for Israel" (p. 103).

- God chose Gideon (a simple farmer) for an important purpose, though he felt unqualified. Can you identify with Gideon, wanting a sign—proof from God—before committing?
