<sup>18</sup> for through him both of us have <u>access</u> in one Spirit to the Father.

- <sup>19</sup>So then you are <u>no longer strangers and aliens</u>,
- **but** you are <u>citizens</u> with the saints
- and also members of the household of God,

<sup>20</sup>built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone.

<sup>21</sup>In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord;

**<u>D. Bonhoeffer</u>**: Cheap grace is the deadly enemy of our Church. We are fighting today for costly grace.

The essence of grace, we suppose, is that the account has been paid in advance; and, because it has been paid, everything can be had for nothing...

...In such a Church the world finds a cheap covering for its sins; no contrition is required, still less any real desire to be delivered from sin.

Cheap grace therefore amounts to a denial of the living Word of God, in fact, a denial of the Incarnation of the Word of God.

#### 1 Corinthians 15:3

Christ died *for our sins* in accordance with the Scriptures

For our sake God made him (Jesus) to be [A SACRIFICE FOR] sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:15-20

<sup>15</sup>[Jesus] *died for all*, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves,

but for him who died and was raised for them.

<sup>16</sup>From now on, therefore,

we regard no one from a human point of view;

-- even though we once knew Christ from a human point of view, we know him no longer in that way.

<sup>17</sup>So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation:

everything old has passed away;

see, everything has become new!

<sup>18</sup>All this is from God, who <u>reconciled</u> us to himself through Christ,

and has given us THE MINISTRY OF RECONCILIATION;

<sup>19</sup>that is, God was in Christ <u>reconciling</u> the world to himself,

not counting their trespasses against them,

and entrusting the message of **reconciliation** to us.

<sup>20</sup>So we are ambassadors for Christ,

—a physical circumcision made in the flesh by human hands

  - without Christ,
