1. PRAY FOR WISDOM FOR EVERYDAY PRACTICAL MATTERS

Choosing Foolishness or Wisdom

Proverbs 10:8; 18:2 -- The **wise** of heart will heed commandments, but a babbling **fool** comes to ruin . . . A **fool** takes no pleasure in understanding, but only in expressing personal opinion.

Handling Money

Proverbs 16:16; 21:20 -- How much better to get **wisdom** than gold! To get **understanding** is to be chosen over silver. Precious treasure remains in the house of the **wise**, but the **fool** devours it.

Learning & Decision Making

Proverbs 10:17; 14:12 -- Whoever heeds instruction is on the path to **life**, but one who rejects a rebuke goes astray. There is a way that seems right to a person, but its end is the way to **death**.

Hard Work

Proverbs 10:26; 12:24 -- Like vinegar to the teeth, and smoke to the eyes, so are the lazy to their employers. The hand of the diligent will rule, while the lazy will be put to forced labor.

<u>Friendship</u>

Proverbs 17:9 -- One who forgives an affront fosters **friendship**, but one who dwells on disputes will alienate a **friend**.

Proverbs 18:24 -- Some friends play at friendship

but a true FRIEND sticks closer than one's nearest kin.

<u>Words</u>

Proverbs 18:21 -- Death and life are in the power of the tongue

Proverbs 10:19 -- When words are many, transgression is not lacking,

Proverbs 16:24 -- Pleasant words are sweet to the soul and health to the body.

<u>The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People</u> by Stephen Covey (each of these can be found in the Bible: especially Proverbs and the teaching of Jesus)

Habit 7: Sharpen the Saw: renew yourself regularly

Habit 6: **<u>Synergize:</u>** work together to achieve more

Habit 5: Seek First to Understand, then to be Understood: listen to people

Habit 4: Think Win-Win: have an "everyone can win" attitude

Habit 3: Put First Things First: prioritize, do the most important things first

Habit 2: Begin with the End in Mind: define your mission and goals in life

Habit 1: Be Proactive: take responsibility for your life

2. PRAY FOR WISDOM FOR RELATIONAL MATTERS

1 Kings 3:16-28 (Solomon and the Two Women) Matthew 5-7, especially 5:21-26 (Jesus' Sermon on the Mount)

3. PRAY FOR WISDOM IN RELIGIOUS MATTERS God's Guidance

Proverbs 16:3, 9 -- Commit your work to the **LORD**, and your plans will be established. The human mind plans the way, but the **LORD** directs the steps.

God's Strength

Proverbs 21:31 -- The horse is made ready for the day of battle, but the victory belongs to the LORD.

God takes care of our Anger

Proverbs 20:22 -- Do not say, "I will repay evil"; wait for the **LORD**, and he will help you.

God provides our Happiness

Proverbs 15:16 --Better is a little with the fear of the **LORD** than great treasure and trouble with it.

God's View of Human Beings

Proverbs 22:2 -- The rich and the poor have this in common: the **LORD** is the maker of them all.

God sees through our Dishonesty and Lies

Proverbs 11:1; 12:22 -- A false balance is an abomination to the LORD, but an accurate weight is his delight. Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, but those who act faithfully are his delight.

God's concern for the Poor

Proverbs 19:17 -- Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the **LORD**, and will be repaid in full.

God's Concern for Justice

Proverbs 21:3 -- To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the **LORD** than sacrifice.

THE WISEST ACT OF ALL: SEEKING JESUS

Matthew 2:11

"On entering the house the Wise Men knelt and paid Jesus homage, opening their treasure chests, and offering gifts . . ."

1 Corinthians 1: 23-25

We preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, *Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God*. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.
